

Faiths United (Tameside)

RULES

1. Associate Membership is open to representatives of statutory organisations and other bodies with an interest in the work of Faiths United (Tameside)
2. Associate Members cannot stand for office or vote.
3. Representatives of other Organisations may also be individual members if they meet the criteria for membership.
4. Any member bringing the reputation of Faiths United (Tameside) into disrepute, or acting in any way to the detriment of the Network, may have their membership terminated by resolution of the committee. They will, however, have the right of appeal to a panel of four members who are not committee members and have played no part in the decision to terminate membership. Any member making such an appeal will have the right to be accompanied.
5. Should any representative of an outside organisation or body act inappropriately as in rule 4 their appointing body will be asked to replace them. Appeal as detailed in rule 4 will also apply.
